Seascape Pool and Spa Rules

NOTICES:

There is not a lifeguard, doctor, or nurse on duty.

You are responsible for your own health and personal welfare, i.e., <u>SWIM AT YOUR</u> OWN RISK

Pool bands must be worn at all times in the pool area by every person 8+ years old Our staff is authorized to remove anyone from the pool area who does not observe these rules.

POOL AND HOT TUB HOURS: 9 AM to 11 PM

SHOWERS: Please shower before entering the pool or hot tubs.

HOT TUB RECOMMENDATIONS:

Hot tub temperature is over 100 degrees. Exposure to hot water may result in nausea, dizziness or fainting.

Persons with weak hearts, elderly persons, pregnant women, and those with health conditions should consult a physician before entering the hot tub.

We recommend you do not use the hot tub alone, or remain in the hot tub longer than 10 minutes.

Hot tub usage is not recommended while under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, or other medications as it may be harmful to your health.

MAIN HOT TUB:

May be used by adults and children 8+ years old. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult.

During the hours 9 PM to 11 PM the hot tub is reserved for adults (18+ years old).

ADULT HOT TUB: For use by adults (18+ years old) only. NO EXCEPTIONS.

SWIM ATTIRE:

Appropriate swimwear must be worn by everyone in the pool and hot tubs. Swimwear normally used by a guest in his/her home culture is considered appropriate. Infants must wear swim diapers. Regular diapers are not permitted.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS:

Plastic containers are recommended for use throughout the entire property and must be used in the pool and hot tub areas.

Use of glass containers is prohibited - NO EXCEPTIONS.

PICNICS:

Food and drink are allowed in the chair/table areas of the pool (not in the hot tub or pool).

Please clean up your area and use the trash receptacles provided.

CONDUCT IN THE POOL AREA:

Running, diving, jumping or horseplay is not permitted.

An adult (18+ years old) must be present at all times with children and non-swimmers. Floats are not permitted in the pool, except for children/non-swimmers using personal floatation devices.

Audio devices are not permitted unless head phones are used.

Please be considerate of others present.

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
